



Your guide to Targeted Agriculture Modernisation Schemes (TAMS 3): Water Quality supports

TAMS 3 provides grants to farmers for new farm buildings and equipment.

- To increase manure and slurry storage capacity.
- To help Farmers achieve national soil, water, and air quality standards.
- To improve animal welfare and farm safety.

There are ten TAMS schemes covering over 400 grant aided items.



TAMS Supports

Up to investment ceiling of **€90,000** and **€160,000** for partnerships

At **40%** generally

At **60%** for Young Farmers, Women Farmers and Organic Farmers

At **70%** for storage facilities for importation of slurry onto the farm

The Farmyard

Use TAMS 3 to maximise the value of your manure by increasing storage capacity so you can choose when to spread during the open period.

TAMS 3 grant aid is available for:

- Concrete Tanks, Precast Tanks, Overground Circular Stores, Lagoons, Slurry Bags and Manure Pits.
- Covering Feed Yards and Collecting Yards to reduce soiled water and slurry storage volumes.
- Slurry Separators to improve efficiency of slurry movements by separating slurry into a solid, friable fraction and a liquid portion.
- Increases tank storage and simplifies spreading, enabling reduction in air and water pollution.
- Rainwater storage tanks.
- Silage Storage Facilities – New and Renovated.
- Safe modern Animal Handling Facilities.

The Land

TAMS 3 grant aid is available for:

- Low Emission Slurry Spreading equipment.
- Slurry flow meters – adjusts the flow of slurry to match your target rate giving you complete control of your slurry application.
- Farm Roadways.
- Cattle and Sheep Fencing (watercourses, drains, roads, Spaces for Nature).
- Solar pumps and solar fencing for out-farms as well as nose pumps.
- GPS Fertiliser and Lime Applicators as well as Sprayers.
- Re-seeding and sward rejuvenation equipment.
