



# EIPs under the previous CAP



- Projects ran from 2017 to 2023
- 57 EIPs
- Total Budget €66 million
- Final Call in December 2022:  
**Farming for Water EIP**





# Learnings from the RDP cycle



- Improve support for participants by providing more detailed guidance and templates and by increased contact through online meetings and site visits.
- Foster greater collaboration and sharing of resources among projects.
- Standardisation of project reporting required to facilitate ease of monitoring and evaluation.
- Increased and improved dissemination of knowledge, data and other outputs from projects.
- Consider the data outputs from the start of the project and put a data management plan in place.

# The EIP Programme under CSP 2023-2027



## STREAM A

- Call 2: Animal Health & Welfare including support for the rearing of pigs with intact tails on Irish farms
- Call 3: Gender Balance in farming in Ireland
- Call 4: Generational Renewal
- Call 5: Digital Tools and Technologies

Total budget of €36 million

Additional fund of €46 million for the Farming for Water EIP from 2025

# Data collection and management

## Data Collection



- What information do you want/need to collect, including personal data?
- Who will use the data?
- What format should it be in?
- How does it link to existing data or research?
- How will the data be verified and by whom?
- How can all outputs, including IP, be made available in the public domain?

# Data collection and management

## 7 principles of GDPR



- **Lawfulness, fairness, and transparency:** Process personal data legally, fairly, and in a transparent way that is understandable to the individual.
- **Purpose limitation:** Collect personal data for explicit, specified, and legitimate purposes and do not process it in a way that is incompatible with those purposes.
- **Data minimization:** Collect only the data that is adequate, relevant, and limited to what is necessary for the purpose it's being processed for.
- **Accuracy:** Ensure the data is accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date. Take every reasonable step to ensure inaccurate personal data is erased or rectified without delay.
- **Storage limitation:** Keep personal data in an identifiable form for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which it is processed.
- **Integrity and confidentiality:** Process personal data in a manner that ensures appropriate security, including protection against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage, using appropriate technical or organizational measures.
- **Accountability:** Be responsible for and able to demonstrate compliance with the other six principles

# Data collection and management

## Who will personal data be shared with?



- The Lead applicant is responsible for putting a Data Protection Policy in place which covers the flow of personal data.
- Data subjects include members of the Operational Group, employees of the OG and participant farmers.
- Personal data includes:
  - *Name*
  - *Date of Birth*
  - *Address*
  - *Eircode*
  - *Phone number*
  - *Email address*
  - *PPSN*
  - *Business ID (e.g. Herd number)*
  - *LPIS number*

# Data collection and management

## Project Outputs – reporting and dissemination



- Standard reporting templates will be provided for the biannual and annual reports – these are high level and focussed on KPI monitoring
- All data in the reports to be anonymised
- Data sets to be created in format suited to sharing
- Consider how data sets can be made available for publication and widespread dissemination e.g. on DAFM open data website




# Data collection and management

## DAFM IT system for sharing spatial data - Data Download



- Onboarding screens for registration of farmer participants by designated EIP team member/s
- Data download function for EIP team member(s) to download spatial data related to their onboarded participants e.g. ACRES/BISS/LPIS
- Access to the DAFM shapefile data will only be granted after the registration request has been approved by DAFM, through direct contact with the farmer



# Data collection and management

## DAFM IT system for sharing spatial data - Data Upload



- Data upload function for transfer of data from EIP project back to DAFM
- EIP team member(s) will be able to use this screen to transfer data from the EIP project back to DAFM
- This will include tabular and spatial datasets


