What is Socially Responsible Public Procurement (SRPP)?

Socially responsible public procurement (SRPP) aims to address the impact on society of the goods, services and works purchased by the public sector. It recognises that public buyers are not just interested in purchasing at the lowest price or best value for money, but also in ensuring that procurement achieves social benefits and prevents or mitigates adverse social impacts during the performance of the contract.

CWMF



- The Capital Works Management Framework is a set of guidelines and tools used by the Irish Government to ensure that public construction projects - like schools, hospitals, and transport infrastructure - are delivered efficiently, cost-effectively, and to a high standard.
- The CWMF provides a structured approach to the planning, procurement, and delivery of public capital projects. It standardises processes across departments and agencies, promotes risk management and accountability, and facilitates consistent documentation and decision-making throughout the project lifecycle.
- Core Objectives
 - Cost certainty
 - Value for money
 - Efficient delivery

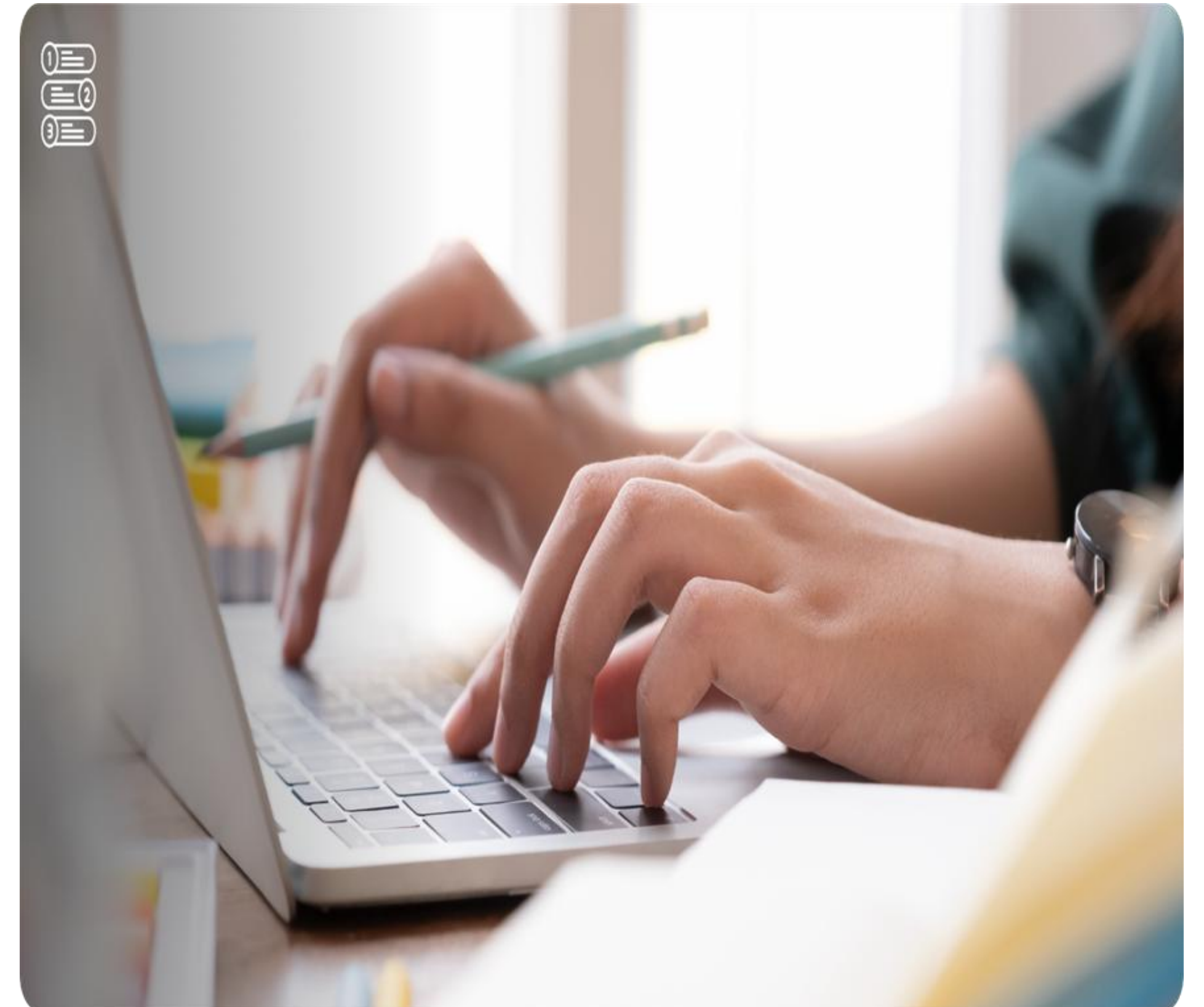
